

NOTICE TO MARINERS

SHEERNESS HARBOUR – ISLE OF GRAIN REPLACEMENT OF CURRENT OUTFALL LIGHT STRUCTURE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on or about Monday 13th January 2014 work will commence on the removal and replacement of the current light structure marking the seaward end of the power station outfall channel, Isle of Grain, Sheerness Harbour.

2. The light is located in the following approximate position:-

51° 26.70' N

00° 43.70' E

The new structure will be in the same position and the light characteristics will be unchanged. During the structure replacement works the navigation light will not be in use.

- 3. The works will take approximately two days and will be carried out by the crane barge "ASWELL", which will be towed to and from the site by the tug "SEA TRACTOR". The safety boat "JESTER" will be in attendance. The "ASWELL" will display the day and night signals as prescribed in the International Regulation for the Prevention of Collision at Sea 1972, as amended. Persons in charge of vessels navigating in the vicinity of the works must keep well clear and exercise care and caution.
